Dhaka, May 11: Bangladesh under-14 national team are flying off to Iran on 16th of this month to participate in an AFC under fourteen festival titled "Fair Play". They will play friendly matches and will show their basic skills in this eight days (May17 to May24) program.

The festival will be held in Hamedan, a little town 336 kilometer away from capital Tehran.
