Dhaka, Oct 31: The Dhaka City Corporation today signed a ten-year contract with Bangladesh Football Federation to sponsor the Pioneer Football League.

The DCC will give Tk 25 lakh for the first year and increase the amount by ten per cent every year during the contract period for the juvenile competition, still regarded as the breeding tournament in Dhaka's football.

The Pioneer League of this season is expected to kick off in November.
